Today's performance features soprano Ellie Dehn who is substituting for soprano Lise Lindstrom.

Only 27 years of age, Miss Dehn's 2007–08 engagements included her return to the Santa Cecilia in Rome where she performed the role of Jemmy in *Guillaume Tell* under the baton of Antonio Pappano, her role debut as Mrs. Naidoo in Glass's *Satyagraha* at the Metropolitan Opera, her debut as Juliette in *Roméo et Juliette* for the Minnesota Opera, and her St. Louis Opera Theatre debut as William Walton's *Cressida* in *Troilus and Cressida*.



In the summer of 2008

Miss Dehn debuted in Ravinia

as Donna Anna with Maestro James Conlon, and also performed Vivaldi's *Gloria* with the Cleveland Orchestra. Future engagements include her debut in Geneva as Agathe in *Der Freischutz*, her debut in Bilbao as Madame Cortese in Rossini's *Viaggio a Reims*, her debut at the Los Angeles Opera as Freia in *Das Rheingold*, and her return to the Cincinnati May Festival for Mahler's 8th Symphony.

Beyond 2009–10 she will return to the Metropolitan Opera as Musetta, the Minnesota Opera for her first Mimi in *Boheme* and a debut at Pesaro's Rossini Opera Festival performing the role of Aldimira in *Sigismondo*. She will also make her San Francisco Opera debut in 2010 as the Countess in Mozart's *Marriage of Figaro*, a role she will also sing with the Houston Grand Opera in 2011. Ms. Dehn debuted the Metropolitan Opera as Marguerite in *Faust* and Teatro Comunale di Bologna as Anne Truelov.

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
